We answer your questions:

### How does GPR work?

Think of GPR as a fish finder for the earth instead of water. It has an antennae which sends a signal and when the signal hits something it bounces back. The signal is strongest when it hits something metallic and weakest when it hits water.

### What can the GPR be used to find?

The GPR does a fantastic job locating utilities. It can tell you the exact location of a utility and estimate depth. It can also be used to locate underground storage tanks including septic tanks.

### Can the GPR be used to find graves?

Yes, the GPR is used to locate

graves and has been used to find Native American grave-sites. Popular TV shows lead you to believe that you will see a skeleton when looking at the GPR screen. That's not the case. You will see disturbed earth that will allow you to narrow your search for possible grave locations.
