The Green Designation Core Course provides real estate professionals with the knowledge and awareness of green building principles in residences, commercial properties, developments, and communities so that they can help consumers in purchasing, retrofitting, and operating green properties. Green building and energy efficiency are “hot topics” in Vermont and across the nation. REALTORS® with a Green Designation are equipped to help consumers make more informed decisions and increase their productivity as a real estate agent.

To earn NAR's Green Designation, REALTORS® must complete a 12-hour Core Course and one of three 6-hour elective courses in residential real estate, commercial real estate, or property management, as well as submit an application and receive approval from the Green REsource Council.
